MINISTER CHIKUNGA TO HOST YOUTH DAY DEBATE WATCH PARTY WITH YOUNG LEADERS

Cape Town: Minister Sindisiwe Chikunga in the Presidency for Women, Youth, and Persons with Disabilities will host a Youth Day Debate Watch Party on Tuesday, 10 June 2025, in partnership with the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa and the National Youth Development Agency (NYDA).

The event forms part of the official build-up to the P20 Youth Parliament on Friday, 13 June 2025 and National Youth Day 2025 Commemoration on 16 June 2025 in Potchefstroom, North west.

The Watch Party will convene over 100 young people – including youth leaders, professionals, creatives, and students – for a day of civic education, direct engagement with Members of Parliament, and live viewing of the Youth Day debate by Members of Parliament in the National Assembly, themed "Skills for a world in the Fourth Industrial Revolution - Empowering the youth for transformative economic participation".

The Watch Party aims to deepen youth participation in democratic processes and ensure the voices of young South Africans are heard in legislative spaces. The programme includes a practical session on how Parliament works facilitated by Hon. Hassan, a meet-and-greet with young MPs, ministers and deputy ministers as well as Presiding Officers facilitated by Hon. Kobe, and a closing reflection facilitated by Hon. Nodada. Minister Chikunga will then provide her closing reflections.
